



ANU INTERHALL SPORT RULES

# VOLLEYBALL



Volleyball will be played according to the rules of the [International Volleyball Federation](#), with specific exceptions listed below.

## EVENT FORMAT

Volleyball is contested as gender-specific men's\* and women's\* round-robin tournaments.

Matches will be played on weekdays between 9am and 5pm. Teams will be seeded according to their result in the competition in the previous year. Finals shall consist of Semi-Finals and a Grand Final. Playoff games shall also be played.

## TEAM SIZE & ELIGIBILITY

Each residential college may name a team of up to 12 players, of which all can take part in any one game. The minimum number of players required at the start of play without incurring a forfeit is 5.

**Per ANU interhall sport rules, each residence is permitted to play one ex-resident\* in any given match.** Note that this ex-resident must still be a student at the ANU.

## MATCH DURATION

All games will be decided by the best of three sets. Set 1 and 2 will be played to 25 points. The deciding set will be played to 15 points. A two-point advantage must be held in order to win a set. Each game will have an allocated time slot of 1 hour.

At the completion of time, the team having won the most number of sets, or if even, the most number of points shall be the winner. In the event of two teams being tied on sets and points at the end of the allocated time, play shall continue until a team has a two-point advantage and is deemed the winner. Substitutions can occur at any time when a point is not being played.

## FORFEITS

If a team does not have 5 players to commence the game within 10 minutes of the scheduled start time, a forfeit shall be declared. Should a forfeit occur, the team which does not forfeit will be deemed to have won. A score of two sets to nil, each set 25-0 will be recorded.

## GAME OFFICIALS

ANU Sport will provide student officials. Each game will have a referee, who will referee the game as well as score. For finals a second official will be provided. **Fill out this [form](#) to express interest.**

## UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT

Competitors should wear the colours and uniform of their residence. Only non-marking shoes are to be worn on courts.

Volleyballs for warm-ups and games will be provided by the colleges/halls. Nets will be set up by ANU Sport and the regulated heights for men's\* and women's\* competitions.

## ANU INTERHALL SPORT POLICIES

All ANU Interhall Sport policies and procedures must be adhered to by all participants. Sports Representatives from each residence are expected to ensure that participants are aware of all of the relevant policies and procedures and act accordingly. *\*Ex residents are required to apply for permission to play for their college before the fixture. This can be done by emailing Olly Ellis with permission from their head of hall and proof of enrollment. Once an ex-resident has completed this process they are eligible to play in any fixture*
