

### Current Structure

#### Who are the members?

#### And how do they become members?

##### Student Members

All ANU students.

All students currently enrolled at the ANU are automatically admitted to become members.

##### Associate Members

Gym and Club members who do not meet the student membership category.

Membership granted upon joining a club or gym and paying the fees associated. E.g \$130 CAF or gym membership.

##### Life Members

Those members who have provided distinguished services to ANU Sport.

Nominated and voted by two thirds of members at an AGM

### Proposed Structure

##### General Members

A person who participates in services or programs provided by ANU Sport e.g; Gym, Club, Interhall Competition and wishes to become a general member.

Complete an application form and demonstrate proof of eligibility

##### Governing Members (voting)

- 1 person nominated by each of the 15 Residential Colleges
- 1 person nominated by each of the 29 Clubs
- 1 person nominated by the University
- 12 Life Members (same as current structure)
- ANU Sport CEO

Complete an application form and demonstrate proof of eligibility

##### Appointed Members

Members appointed by the board or University to sit on the ANU Sport board

Determined by majority vote at relevant board meeting

## WHY IS THIS REQUIRED?

The main reason for the change is to enable ANU Sport to comply with legislative requirements (including health and safety requirements). As recommended in the 2021 Governance Review, the change in membership structure separates those individuals who wish to be involved in ANU Sport's governance processes from those who simply wish to participate in the various sport & wellbeing programs on offer. The proposed structure is more reflective of the stakeholders who actively engage with ANU Sport. The proposed changes also aim to reduce administrative burden for clubs by enabling flexibility for clubs to maintain their own membership lists without having to use UniOne.

### What about fees?

There will be no additional fees for any members as they are already built into the existing costs of participation. E.g. Fitness centre fees, \$130 Club Affiliation fee, UniSport registration fees.
